Transportation

AIR: LA/Ontario International Airport (owned and operated by Los Angeles World Airports), 42 mi. northwest, is served by AeroMexico, Alaska Airlines, American Airlines, Continental, Delta Airlines, Great Lakes Airlines, Southwest Airlines, Ted, United Airlines, United Express and US Airways. County-owned French Valley Airport in Murrieta is a general aviation facility and handles small crafts. Additional air service is available from San Diego, Los Angeles and Orange County airports.

PORTS: Nearest ports are in Los Angeles-Long Beach, 85 mi. west, and San Diego, 79 mi. south.

HIGHWAYS: I-215 north-south. There are nearby connections to the I-15 north-south, Calif. 74 eastwest, and Calif. 79 north to I-10.

Industrial Sites

Menifee is currently developing its first General Plan. Until the city completes the processes on the General Plan, it will continue to use the Riverside County General Plan. In Menifee's proposed General Plan, 28 acres are zoned for heavy industrial use and 1,274 acres are zoned for light industrial use. The proposed industrial parcels are mostly located in the northern area of Menifee in Focus Area 1 at Ethanac Road/Highway 74 and Matthews Road and in the southern part of Menifee in Focus Area 5 at I-215/ Scott Road.

Labor Market Area

Extent of Unionization: Generally includes retail clerks and building trades.

The broader Menifee labor market includes populations from San Diego, Orange County and Northwest Riverside County, providing a sizable work force that is accessible for the employment needs of current and future businesses. Most workers commute to jobs in nearby communities, especially Murrieta, Temecula, Corona, Perris, Riverside and more distant points, such as San Diego, Orange and Los Angeles counties.

Community Facilities

Menifee Valley Medical Center, an 84-bed hospital is located in the city and Inland Valley Medical Center, a 122-bed hospital is located in nearby Wildomar. Rancho Springs Medical Center, a 96-bed hospital, is located in Murrieta.

HEALTH: 17 physicians/surgeons, 4 optometrists, 19 dentists and 4 chiropractors practice in Menifee.

EDUCATION: The Menifee Union School District has 8 elementary schools, 2 middle schools and 1 K-12 school. The Romoland Elementary School District has 3 elementary schools and 1 middle school. The Perris Union High School District has 1 middle school, 3 comprehensive high schools, 1 online alternative school, 1 continuation high school, 1 community day school, 1 military institute and 1 adult school. Two private schools are located in Menifee. The city is home to Mt. San Jacinto College, Menifee Valley Campus. Other institutions of higher education accessible to Menifee residents include the University of California, Riverside, California State University, San Bernardino and California State University, San Marcos in Temecula.

CULTURAL: 31 churches, 2 synagogues, 2 libraries, 2 newspapers, 2 Cable TV systems, 4 banks, 23 parks, a community center, a senior center and a cultural center. Menifee Lakes Country Club offers two 18-hole championship courses. Other nearby recreational facilities include Lake Perris State Park, Perris Valley Airport (flying, international sky-diving center, ballooning), Diamond Valley Lake and to the south, the Temecula Valley Wine Country.

According to the California Department of Finance, there are 29,367 housing units in Menifee. The housing stock consists of 23,684 single detached units, 848 single attached units, 301 multiple 2 to 4 units, 675 multiple 5 plus units and 3,859 mobile homes.

The median sales price for new and existing homes in Menifee is \$195,000, as reported by DataQuick for October 2009.

There are 3 hotels/motels in Menifee.

There are 5 mobile home and RV parks in Menifee with 1,194 mobile home spaces and 523 RV spaces.

The city of Menifee was established on October 1, 2008 as Riverside County's twenty-sixth city. Early development of Menifee began with Sun City in the early 1960s as the concept of an active retirement community envisioned by Arizona developer Del Webb. Sun City is centrally located within Menifee, with a mix of residential and commercial activity. The Menifee area began to grow further in 1989 with the master-planned community of Menifee Lakes. Other neighborhoods include Quail Valley, a semirural residential community and Romoland, a residential and commercial area located in the northeastern section of the city.

As the city continues to refine its vision for the future with community-established guiding principles of self governance and economic and environmental sustainability, Menifee's future is bright. Menifee continues to be one of the fastest growing cities in California. Its excellent quality of life and convenient location on the I-215 corridor will continue to attract business and residents.
