

ONSITE CAMPING RULES - Some of the information here may be updated as the festival approaches or situations change. It is advisable to check for updates regularly or at least close to the festival weekend before you head out.

\$500 ANY WEEKEND (ELECTRIC ONLY) INCLUDES ONE (1) COMPANION VEHICLE PARKING PASS

\$600 ANY WEEKEND (FULL HOOK-UP (W/S/E) - LIMITED AVAILABILITY) INCLUDES ONE (1) COMPANION VEHICLE PARKING PASS

\$40.00 COMPANION PARKING PASS FOR ADDITIONAL VEHICLES

\$50 SHUTTLE PASS EVERY PERSON (REQUIRED)

Please be advised! Each person will be required to have purchased their Coachella and/or Stagecoach Festival wristband in order to stay in the County Fairgrounds RV Parking.

All campers and vehicles are subject to search when entering. Only person(s) hooking up RV's for campers are permitted upon initial entry.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- X NO chains/chain wallets
- X NO drugs & drug paraphernalia
- X NO weapons
- X NO pets
- X NO portable generators
- X NO fireworks/explosives
- 🗙 NO golf carts, dune buggies, off road motorcycles, Segways, horses
- X NO spray paint
- X NO slip & slides or inflatable pools
- X NO tents

RV PARK HOURS

- RV Park is open from the Thursday prior to Festival at 8 am through Monday at 12 noon. <u>PLEASE DO NOT</u> <u>ARRIVE EARLY.</u> Once you have parked your RV there will be no in or out privileges. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- All RV Entry will be through Gate 6. Final exiting of RV's will be through Gate 5 & Gate 9.
- The RV Park opens that Thursday prior to the Festival. It is only open for check in during the following hours: Thursday: 8 am to 10 pm & Friday: 8 am to 10 pm

RV PARK RULES

- Check-in at Gate 6 off Dr. Carreon Blvd.
- **EACH RV WILL BE LIMITED TO SIX (6) OCCUPANTS PER RV UNIT.**
- Every person is required to purchase a \$50 Shuttle Pass for transportation to and from the Festival.
- All persons staying in RV must show ID (Driver's license or State ID) at time of check in. Upon verification a wristband will be issued that must be worn at all times.
- Every person must wear wristband issued by Fairgrounds to gain re-entry into RV Park. Wristband must be shown to security or staff. <u>ONLY DATE FESTIVAL CAMPERS WITH WRISTBANDS WILL BE ALLOWED ON</u> <u>PROPERTY.</u>
- Each RV parking space is a 20x50 square foot area any weekend. Fair staff will assign your RV Space. Fairgrounds staff have designated parking locations for each RV according to length & size.
- All RV spaces require an RV, trailer, or camper to be placed. No tents are allowed.
- Saving spots will not be allowed. If you want to camp together you must arrive together. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- All RV's must be classified as a "vehicle made for sleeping" to RV camp. There will be no camping or sleeping out of any vehicles.
- Feel free to bring your own food and beverages into the camping area; however no open fires, or charcoal BBQ's are allowed.
- No pet allowed but does not apply to documented service dogs.

COMPANION VEHICLES

- No vehicles other than the RV you are sleeping in are allowed in the RV camping areas. This includes any vehicle not towing a trailer/5th wheel. If you are towing a trailer/5th wheel and decide to un-hook and drive that vehicle you must have a Companion Vehicle Parking Pass and park in the companion car parking lot.
- If your RV is towing a vehicle or additional travel trailer you must unhook and park that tow item in companion parking. Absolutely NO towed motorized vehicles allowed in camping areas.
- When you purchase an RV spot, a courtesy companion vehicle parking pass will be issued to you <u>if requested</u> during the registration process.
- If the rest of your party is meeting you later and will need vehicle parking; you must purchase a Companion Vehicle Parking Pass for \$40.00 and register the additional vehicle during the registration process. This pass must be purchased at time of RV Space Purchase.
- With this pass you will be free to drive in and out of this lot.
- ✤ YOU CAN NOT PURCHASE COMPANION PARKING PASSES ALONE.

SHUTTLE BUS

- Every camper is required to purchase a \$50 Shuttle Pass for transportation to and from Stagecoach Festival. The wristband issued at initial check in will be required to board Shuttle Bus.
- Shuttle pick up is available at Gate 6 outside RV check in.
- Shuttle hours will be from 11 am to 1 hour after close of show.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Campers are expected to behave in a manner that is courteous to other campers. A 1:30 a.m. noise curfew will be enforced. All campers must be 18 years of age or older with proper ID. All minors must be accompanied by a parent. Venue is not responsible for any materials lost or stolen. Lock up your valuables.

The following actions will result in a warning – If an individual participating in this behavior is uncooperative or a persistent offender; he/she will be removed from the RV Park. In certain situations the offender may be arrested.

- X Irresponsible use of alcohol
- X Public nudity or obscene or vulgar clothing
- × Accessing restricted areas
- X Taunting, abusive or disruptive language or obscene gestures
- X Moving RV to another location
- × Parking or extending any part of RV in fire lanes or outside designated area

The following actions will result in immediate ejection. In addition, the offender may be arrested.

- X Urinating in public
- X Fighting or engaging in any action that may harm, endanger, threaten or bring discomfort to anyone
- X Engaging in sexual behavior in public
- X Possession/use of illegal drugs
- X Damage, destruction, vandalism or theft of any property
- X Dumping of any tanks on fairgrounds

ALCOHOL & DRUG POLICY

- No glass containers of any kind.
- Each patron age 21 or older with valid ID may enter the campgrounds with two of the following: Case of beer, alcohol in plastic 1 liter bottle, or boxed wine. NO KEGS or GLASS containers.
- No drug paraphernalia or drugs allowed. These items will be confiscated and law enforcement notified.
- No weapons of any kind. These items will be confiscated.
- No providing alcohol to minors or in any way contributing to the intoxication of a minor or you will be ejected from the venue without a refund and subject to arrest.

GETTING AROUND TOWN

- Golf carts, dune buggies, off road motorcycles, Segways, horses, etc. of any kind will not be allowed on the premises, even in companion parking.

- Nearest bus stops are at the front gate on Hwy 111 & the back gate on Dr. Carreon Blvd.
